

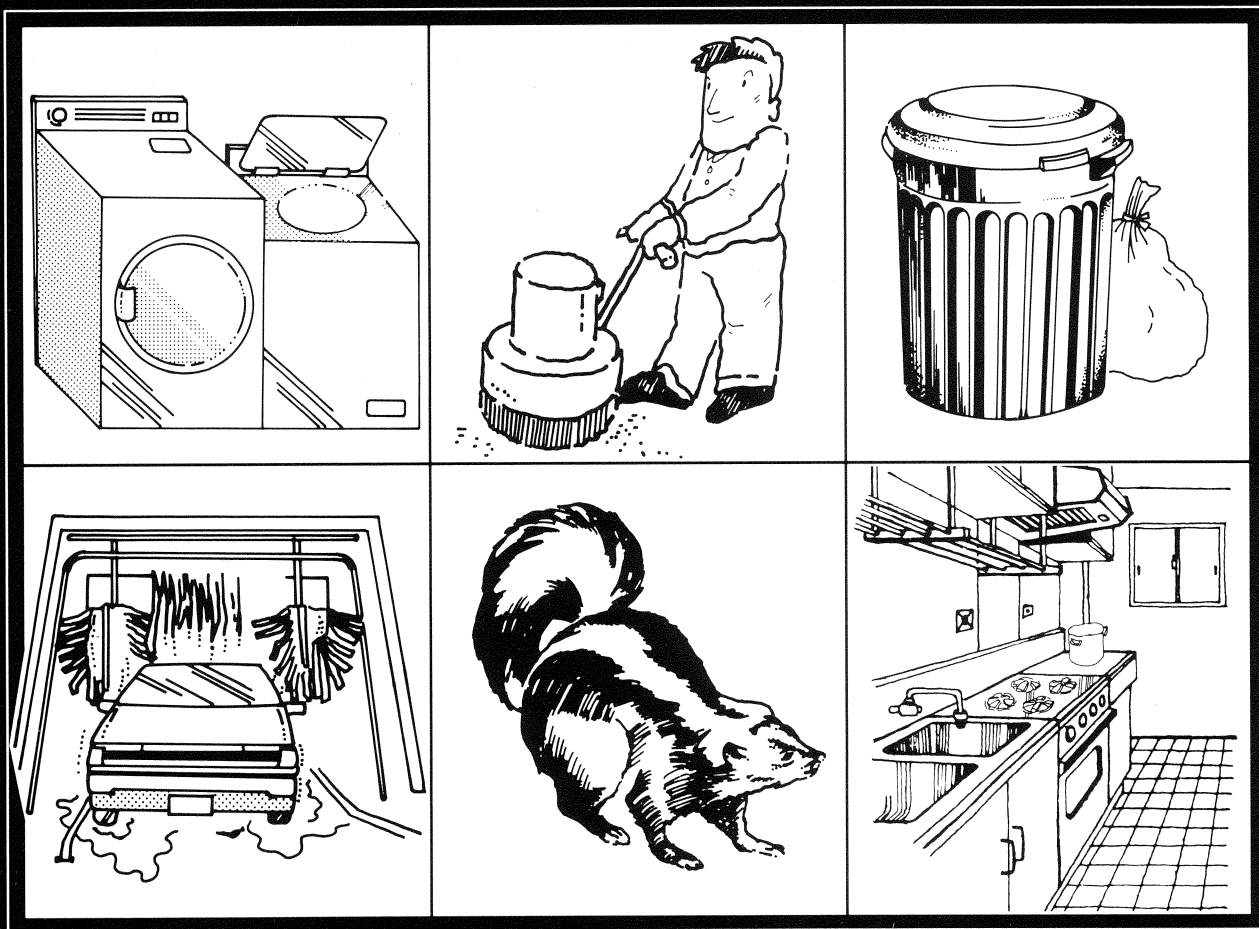

Epoleon is a deodorizer made from fine, organic chemicals and complex compounds. Epoleon is biodegradable, emulsifiable, and a dissolver and neutralizer of malodors. Being an "Amphi-Deodorizer" Epoleon automatically and simultaneously reacts on gases from acidic to alkaline to remove the malodors by a method of chemical

reaction. Epoleon has been tested both chemically and scientifically and is the result of many years of research. It contributes in cleaning the air environment of our society by decomposing the malodors of gases. Epoleon is a chemical product manufactured with substances that do not contain toxic or poisonous components.

FLOOR OF KITCHEN:

For deodorizing hotel and restaurant kitchens, floors, walls and shelves during cleaning at the end of a workday, either dilute 1/2 gallon of EPOLEON NnZ with 5 gallons of tap water (1:10 dilution) and sprinkle about 3.5 oz. per 10 sq. ft., or use EPOLEON NnZ-saturated mop, and rinse the floor with drinkable (tap) water afterwards. When a deck brush or floor washer is used for washing after spraying, extraneous materials such as oils from floors, walls, etc., can be washed away and the deodorizing effect will be enhanced at the same time.

FOR DEODORIZING CONTAINERS AND UTENSILS USED IN FOOD PLANTS ETC:

Spray them with the above mentioned 1:10 dilution of EPOLEON NnZ or soak them in the diluted EPOLEON NnZ until odor-free, and rinse them out with tap water.

FOR DEODORIZING DRAINS AND DRAIN HOSES IN SINKS AND WASHING PLACES:

Apply 3–4 oz. of concentrated EPOLEON NnZ along the inside walls of the drains to deodorize them. All extraneous materials can be cleaned away from drains and drain hoses (pipes) inside walls at the same time: **Note:** For use in plants and kitchens where food and beverages are processed, potable (tap) water for dilution and rinsing, after using EPOLEON NnZ are mandatory USDA requirements. Do not sprinkle EPOLEON NnZ directly on food and beverage items. Also, when using EPOLEON NnZ, remove or cover (with leak-proof covers) all food and beverage items.

FOR DEODORIZING GARBAGE AND MEAL SCRAPS, ETC., IN KITCHENS AND FOOD PLANTS:

Sprinkle the refuse thoroughly with 1:10 dilution of EPOLEON NnZ.

FOR DEODORIZING TRUCKS AND CONTAINERS USED FOR TRANSPORTING FOOD AND BEVERAGES:

Dilute 1/4 gallon of EPOLEON NnZ with 5 gallons of tap water (1:20 dilution) and sprinkle in a ratio of 5 gallons for a 10-ton truck. After sprinkling, brush the interior with a deck brush, etc., and rinse with tap water.

FOR DEODORIZING WATER ABSORBENT CONTAINERS MADE OF WOOD, ETC:

Sprinkle them with EPOLEON NnZ and brush, as above, then rinse with tap water after leaving them untouched for 6-12 hours.

FOR DEODORIZING FOOD-PLANT STOREROOMS AND MOLDY ODORS IN THE BASEMENT:

Dilute 1 gallon of EPOLEON NnZ with 20 gallons of tap water, and after sprinkling 3 oz. per 10 sq. ft., wash with a deck brush or automatic floor scrubber. After washing, remove as much moisture as possible with a dry mop or vacuum cleaner.

FOR DEODORIZING RECYCLED WATER USED IN CAR WASHES:

Use 1 gallon of EPOLEON NnZ for every 1000 gallons of recirculated water.

FOR DEODORIZING IN LAUNDRY PLANTS:

In cleaning/laundry plants where large volumes of laundry are processed (continuous systems), deodorizing can be accomplished with a mixture of EPOLEON NnZ and detergent in the detergent-release container. **EXAMPLE:** After dissolving about 80 lbs. of detergent in approx. 180 gallons of water, add about 1.5 gallons of EPOLEON NnZ, and while gently stirring it add the rest of the water to make approximately 240 gallons of mixture. After mixing, 240 gallons of the mixture (1 ton) can be used for laundering 12,000 lbs. (6 tons) of the wash load. For application to a batch system or small-volume laundry, (for home use, etc.), either add it directly into the washer during washing, or add it immediately before the final rinse, and thoroughly rinse the load by agitating it for 3–4 minutes. The dosage is 1 oz. of EPOLEON NnZ for 20 gallons of water. **Note:** EPOLEON NnZ is not usable for dry cleaning.

FOR CARPET CLEANING:

After diluting 1 gallon of EPOLEON NnZ with 10 gallons of water (1:10 dilution) and sprinkling 2 oz. per 10 sq. ft., the carpet can be washed. In areas where urine (human or animal), vomit, etc. have soaked in, sprinkle approximately 2 oz. more into the area, and after EPOLEON NnZ has saturated the area, washing can be done. When using a carpet-cleaning machine, mix with the cleaning agent by adding EPOLEON NnZ into the container fitted into the machine. It is compatible with almost any cleaning agent. However, since a variety of carpet-cleaning agents exist, it should be tested on a tabletop first. If sedimentation or a two-layer liquid forms, it should not be used.

Note: Do not use EPOLEON NnZ on furs that require dry cleaning or on carpets that contain animal fibers.

FOR DEODORIZING WINERIES AND WHISKEY PLANTS AND WAREHOUSES:

Sprinkle diluted (1:10 dilution) EPOLEON NnZ on the floors, and rinse it with tap water at the end of the workday.

FOR RESTAURANTS:

EPOLEON NnZ contains emulsifying agents which enable it to break up grease and oil buildup in kitchen areas. It can be poured into drains or into grease traps, diluted 10 to 50 times, and used to clean kitchen floors, counters etc. EPOLEON NnZ can also be used with other cleansers if necessary.

The above EPOLEON NnZ dosage/mixture rates are basic. The dosage will vary depending on the situations, temperature, etc. To obtain better results, increase the amount of EPOLEON NnZ.
